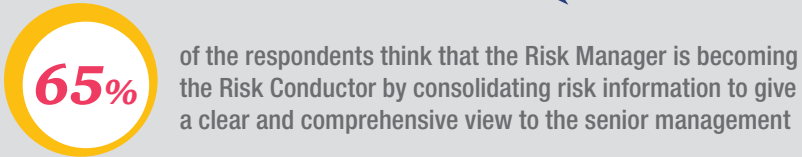

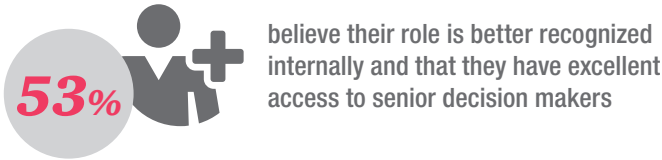

Who is the risk manager?

69% men and 31% women

+4% women since 2016

Usually has more than 10 years of experience

Typically between 36 and 55 years old

Most earned between €60 k to €100 k par year



Activities of the Risk Manager



39%

are in charge of ERM



33%

are in charge of both ERM and insurance management



28%

are in charge of insurance management

Risk Managers have never been closer to the heart of innovation



44%

are using data analysis and modelling tools

8%

are already using emerging technologies (Robotic Process Automation or Blockchain...)

The Insurance Manager is closely following innovative trends

85%

of the Insurance Managers are concerned or extremely concerned about the limitations and exclusions on emerging/specific risks

of the Insurance Managers, think that managing a captive will play a more important role to cover the non-traditional risks such as cyber risks or political risks
